2022 HEPHZIBAH COMMUNITY CHRISTMAS PARADE

December 17, 2022 Participant Rules

1. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE ON A FLOAT OR A STAND-ALONE VEHICLE. NO WALKING UNITS ALLOWED WITH THE EXCEPTION OF A COLOR GUARD AND HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND WHICH ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN THEIR UNIFORMS. The goal is to have the parade continuously moving without stops which cause large gaps in between entries creating safety issues.

- 2. Candy may be tossed from any entry towards the crowd at their feet.
- 3. All floats MUST be decorated with a CHRISTMAS theme. Decorations are the responsibility of the participants.
- 4. All vehicles in the parade must be in good working order and are required to comply with rule #3. Antique vehicle and go-cart units are exempt from rule #3.
 - 5. All traffic laws must be obeyed at all times. All drivers must be licensed.
- 6. No one is allowed to leave or enter an entry after the parade starts with the exception of City of Hephzibah Public Safety personnel.
- Line-up for the Parade will be at the Hephzibah-Carroll Community Center parking lot and will start at 8:00 a.m. Participants are required to be in place and ready to roll at 9:30 a.m. Participants are also required to keep their line-up area clean.
- 8. The official parade route is on Hwy 88 from Reynolds Street to Windsor Spring Road. Participants are required to return to the Hephzibah-Carroll Community Center to unload any passengers.

9. All entries will be required to display their entry number on the right rear quarter panel of the tow vehicle, or stand-alone vehicle. The numbers will be provided at line-up by the Parade Committee and serve as the official identification for judges. The Judges' decisions are final.

10. Unsigned or incomplete entry forms will not be accepted.

11. NO SANTAS (costumed, inflatable, etc.) are allowed on/with any entry.

Entry into the Parade is conditional upon compliance with Parade guidelines. You may be denied entry for non-compliance and at the discretion of the Parade Committee. Keep this page for your information.
